

# HOTCOTE™ INSTALLATION TECHNIQUES



## **INSULATING LINE POSTS:**

Pin-lock or claw-style insulators can be used at lines posts. A tube insulator, secured with a 2" wide staple, can also be used. Do not drive the staple tight against the Hotcote.



## **JOINING:**

Slide up to a 4' piece of Hotcote tubing onto the wire before attaching crimp sleeves. Use the tubing to cover the join and any possible retraction that may occur.



## **END POST ATTACHMENT:**

Use wraparound insulators on end posts. Install insulated, underground wire to transfer electric under gates.



## **TENSIONING:**

Install a permanent in-line strainer at the midpoint of the fence to make re-tensioning easy. Use a 4" piece of Hotcote tubing to cover crimp sleeves and exposed wire.



## **CORNER POST:**

The corner collar fits perfectly onto wood posts to make insulating around corners fast and easy.

**Safety Note: Use protective eye wear and gloves. It is essential to keep fence line clear of all debris.**

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
