Introduction:

The S7 model 6000 is made of solid stainless steel. It is made to tie high tensile wire. **THE DRIVE IS STORED INSIDE THE HANDLE**

Safety Practices:

1. Read this manual and become familiar with this tool before use.
2. Protective eyewear must be worn during use.
3. Wear appropriate gloves for handling wire.
4. Always run tool at a slow safe speed.
5. Never attempt to grab wire when tool is in motion.
6. Care should be taken to keep hands and fingers away from pinch points.

Operating Instructions:

1. If you are installing net wire, strip all the upright stays and cut all the fixed knots off, until there is enough slick wire to wrap post and tie.
2. Make your wrap on the post then one wrap around line wire leaving the tail as straight as possible or slightly curved back toward the post as in picture below.



3. Cut the tail of the remaining wire short enough to miss line wire above and below while it wraps.
4. Line up the slot on the tool, slide the tool on the line wire. Once the tool is securely centered on the line wire, then slide the tool up on the wrap, towards the post, engaging only the tail. Insert drill drive into tool holding the handle of the tool firmly.



5. Start the drill as slow as possible to make sure the rotation is the same direction as wrap you started. After approximately one revolution of the tool push it firmly toward the post. This will make tight, close wraps.
6. Operate the tool, wrapping the wire until desired amount of wraps.
7. Back the tool off the wraps turning it slowly. Align the slot in the tool. Stop the drill then pull the tool off the line wire.
8. If done correctly, it should look like tie below.



Maintenance:

The S7 Model 6000 does not require a lot of maintenance. Keep dirt out as much as possible. Lubricate shaft occasionally as shown in picture

below.
